PUBLIC HEARING

A Public Hearing was advertised and held by the Hempfield Township Board of Supervisors on Wednesday, November 7th, 2018, at 6:45 P.M. at the Hempfield Township Municipal Building.

Chairman Hittle opened the meeting. All of the Supervisors were present. Mr. Paul C. Rankin, Vice President Retail Marketing for United Refining Company of Pennsylvania attended on behalf of Country Fair, Inc. The purpose of the meeting was to take public input on a request to transfer a Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board License from the Borough of Wheatland to Hempfield Township on behalf of Country Fair, 14 Hadley Road, Greenville, PA through Resolution R12-2018.

Chairman Hittle instructed the Secretary to read Resolution R12-2018 and hear testimony. Secretary Hittle read Resolution R12-2018. Mr. Paul C. Rankin, representing Country Fair gave testimony on the floor layout/remodeling that will be installed to meet state requirements, showed locations of coolers and check-out stations for alcohol sales.

Chairman Hittle thanked Mr. Rankin for his presentation and asked if there were any additional comments. There were none. Chairman Hittle stated that Resolution R12-2018 was listed for discussion and adoption at the regular monthly meeting that would follow the Public Hearing at 7:00 P.M today.

Chairman Hittle made a motion to adjourn the public hearing and Supervisor Hittle duly seconded the motion. Motion carried.
